The spreading of news during the first decades of the 16<sup>th</sup> century played a crucial role during the French Wars of Religion and in the dawn of the Dutch Revolt. Letters, broadsheets, broadsides and pamphlets formed in addition to the oral tradition new information channels. Thanks to the use of the printing press and wide mobility of merchants, humanists and preachers as well as literary contacts between them a new market for news has been created. The main goal of the 4<sup>th</sup> edition of Polish-Belgian workshop and symposium organized by the University of Antwerp and the Jagiellonian University was to discuss the relations between the narrative and graphic sources and their communication strategies during the first years of the Dutch Revolt.
